I. <u>Eligibility</u>

Minimum second-class or equivalent grade in the qualifying degree. A qualifying degree could be one of the following

- Master's degree in the Mathematical or Physical Sciences,
- B.E./B.Tech. (or equivalent degree) in an appropriate field of Engineering or Technology.

II. Qualifying examinations

The candidate should also have passed one of the following entrance tests:

- Qualified in the Doctoral scholarship conducted by NBHM
- CSIR-UGC NET for JRF
- DST-Inspire fellowships

Applicants must have passed one of the specified qualifying exams.

III. <u>Selection process</u>

Tier 1: Initial Screening

Eligible candidates must take the Selection Examination scheduled on July

13, 2025. Candidates who have secured NBHM scholarship are exempted from this screening process.

Tier 2: Interview

Candidates who qualify in the written examination will be called for a subsequent interview.
